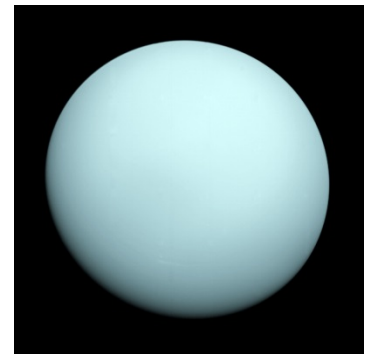


Exhibit of Japanese Festivities
