
The 31st Annual Fukui Spring Festival

Need-based financial aid is offered to Elementary and Junior High school students whose families have difficulty paying school expenses.

Criteria

- -Fukui city residents
- -Family with children who attend elementary schools/ Jr. High schools
- -Having difficult financial situation, but not qualified to receive public assistance (*Seikatsu Hogo*)
- -Having financial difficulty recently by a sudden change in living condition
- *There is an income limit for applying this assistance



Echizen Railway and Fukui Railway Will Start a Shared Operation

Echizen Railway's train route is from Mikuni Minato to Fukui Guchi, whereas Fukui Railway's train route is from Tawara Machi to Echizen Takefu. Because of that, the passenger will have to transfer at Tawara Machi if they want to go from Mikuni to Echizen Takefu and vice versa.

In order to avoid such inconvenience, from March 27th (Sun), Echizen Railway and Fukui Railway will share a track (*please look below for the time table*) so that the passengers can go from Washizuka Haribara to Echizen Takefu directly without transferring at Tawara Machi.


