Presently, Fukui City is carrying out the 6th Fukui City Comprehensive Plan and will continue to do so until the end of the Heisei 28 fiscal year. Following the conclusion of this plan, the 7th Fukui City Comprehensive Plan will be implemented from Heisei 29 to Heisei 33.
