Contents: Consultation about tax payment, payment of the City tax, application for City tax payment by bank transfer

*City tax includes City/Prefectural residence tax, Fixed property tax, Light-motor vehicle tax and the National Health Insurance tax.

Things to bring: Your photo ID (Driver's license, etc.)

*To apply for the bank transfer payment, you need to bring your tax notice, a cash card or bank book of the bank account you want to use for the payment and the stamp used to open the account.
