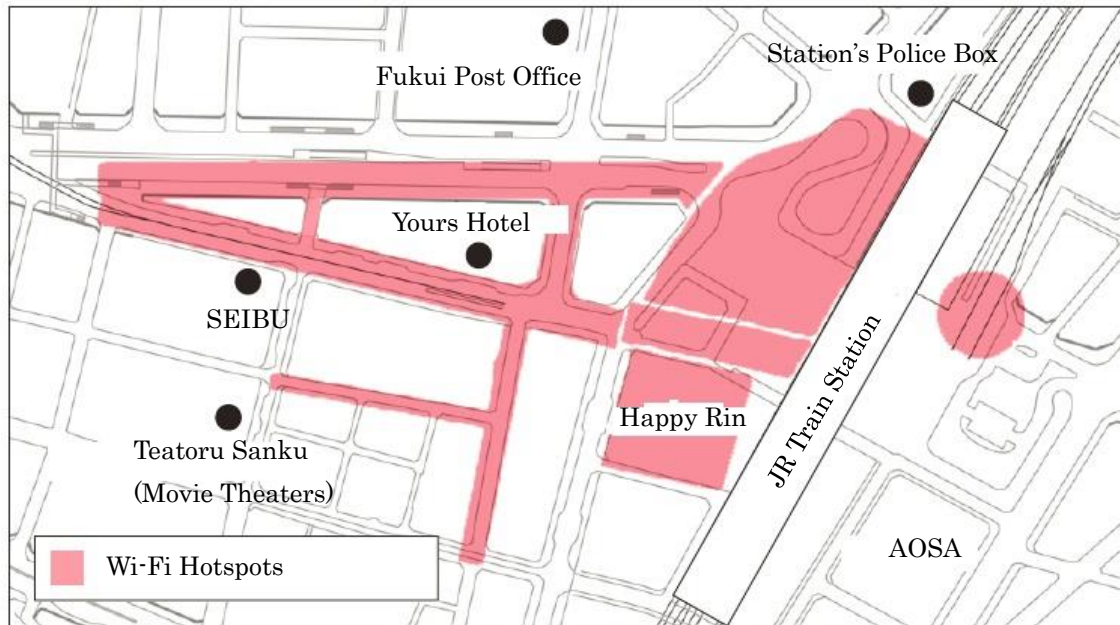
Minimum Wage

On October 1, 2016, the minimum hourly wage was raised to ¥754. This applies to all employees and employers in Fukui prefecture.

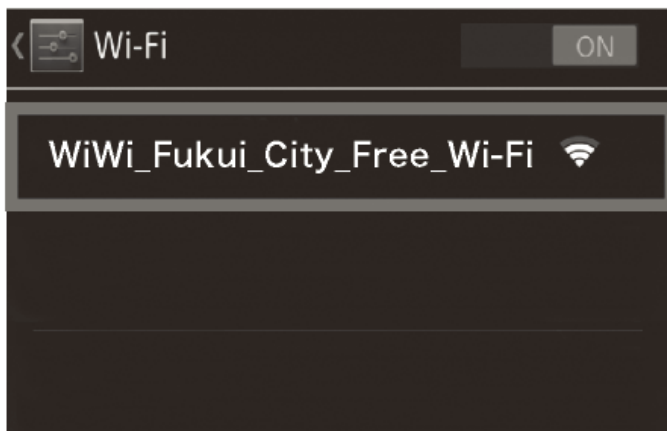
