Following the guidelines for taking out trash

When taking out the trash, please follow the following guidelines. If you don't, your trash will not be collected, so please be aware. Also, please follow the rules set after each residence association meeting.

Separating your trash

After separating the trash, each bag should contain no more than 5 kilograms. Do not put non-disposable items in bags.

Check which types of trash are allowed to be put out

On the set day and at the set time

Depending on the quantity of trash, the traffic conditions, and weather, the time that trash is collected can happen before or after the set time, so to be safe, please set your trash out at your designated area by 7:00 am.

Set trash out on the day it is to be collected

Designated Areas

Set out your trash in your designated area determined by your residence association.

Do not set out your trash non-designated areas.
