Around then end to the beginning of the year, the actual time that one's garbage is collected may shift from the scheduled time depending on the amount of traffic and garbage being collected. Therefore, please set out your trash by 7am to avoid not having your trashed collected.

Attention: Norovirus season is coming back!

Norovirus spreads quickly around December and January. Preventing yourself from getting infected is important.

Symptoms: Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, stomach pain, fever

Where the virus can be found: food or drinks that are contaminated with norovirus, vomit and stools of infected people, cough and sneeze of infected people, etc.

Prevention:

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap before cooking, after eating, and after using a bathroom.
- People who have diarrhea and vomit should avoid handling food
- Wear apron, gloves, and mask to clean vomits and stools before they are dry and put them in a plastic bag. In case the floor gets dirty from it, disinfect with Sodium hypochlorite.
- Microwave the food thoroughly for at least 90 seconds.
- After washing dishes, disinfect them in boiling water for over a minute.
