*Only 10 total issues (3 issues per title) per person.

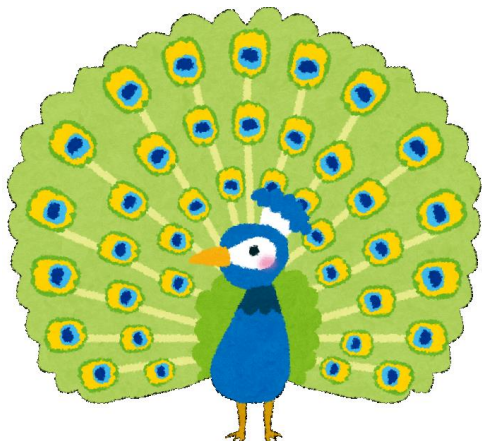
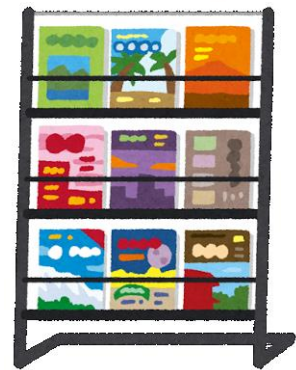
