Fukumyu Pass and Rally

Fukumyu Pass:

The fukumyu pass allows one to visit Fukui's museums at a reasonable price. One can purchase the pass at the tourist information desk or the following participating establishments.

Fee: All day pass –400 yen; 3 day pass–800 yen

Fukumyu pass covers:

Entry access at:	Ichijo Dani Asakura Family Ruins (Town exhibit), Yokokan Garden, Osagoe Folk Village Museum, (Daffodil Dome • Koshino Furusato Museum [Echizen Suisen no Sato Park])

*If one presents the pass at the permanent exhibit and Ichijo Dani Asakura Family Ruins Museum, one will be discounted and charged at group rate.

Fukumyu Rally:

We invite you to go around and collect stamps at Fukui City's museum. Ask the following participating museums for a stamp card (Simply mention stamp rally card.) There are 17 places in total. Upon one's 3rd and 8th visit, one will receive original merchandise from the establishment at which he or she is. When one has visited all 17 places, he or she will receive a bag with the original goods from all 17 places. One may still receive a stamp at admission-paid establishments on days with free entry. In addition, handicapped individuals may also participate in the rally.
