Steps to Disaster Drill

1. A bell will ring at 8:00am
2. Do the earthquake drill in your home
3. Take your emergency bag to the evacuation area of the resident association (The area is determined by the resident association)
4. The leader of the resident association takes the roll call and checks for the safety
5. Relocate to evacuation area of the district
6. Fire drill and first-aid training will be conducted

We will use the observatory's astronomical telescope to observe Jupiter's stripes and satellites.

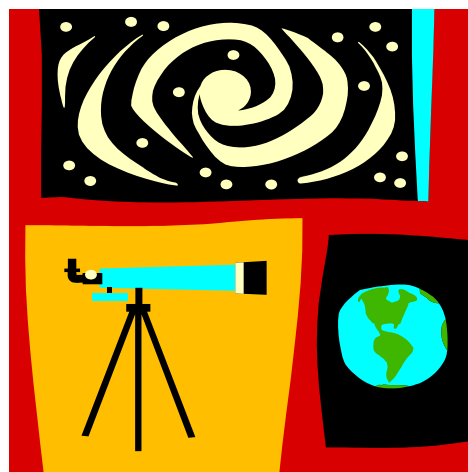
Date & Time: June 17th (Saturday)
