# Preventing Infection from Pathogens Carried by Mosquitoes and Ticks

#### ◆ Protection from Mosquitoes –

Follow the following steps to avoid getting bitten by mosquitoes and effectively reducing the number of mosquito outbreaks:

1. Get rid of places for mosquitoes to hide by periodically weeding and removing/cleaning up any excess or puddles of water.



2. When visiting places where mosquitos might be present such as areas with tall grass, cover up your skin as much as possible and use bug spray.

#### Protection from Ticks –

Ticks are the most active throughout spring until fall. When visiting areas where large number of ticks inhabit, such as areas with tall grass, please be adhere to the following:

- 1. Wear long sleeves, pants, socks that completely cover your feet, and gloves.
- 2. Reduce skin exposure by wrapping a towel around your neck, etc.
- 3. Wear bright clothing on which ticks are found easily.


