

## 5 New Bicycles Stations Added!

In Fukui City, 5 new bicycle stations have been added to the count to currently add up to 37 total stations.

You can pump your tires (depending on the station, it may only have Dunlop/Woods Valve, but others should have both Schraeder and Presta Valves as well) or readjust anything with equipment in their tool kit for free left at designated stations.

There are also restrooms at some locations, so if you ever feel like you need to inflate your tires, take a short break, or use the restroom, feel free to use any of these bike stations!

## Autumn Fire Prevention Practices

November 9<sup>th</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup> is the week for raising awareness regarding fire prevention practices. As the usage of things such as heaters increases, the amount of flammable things increases as well (such as your favorite warm fleece blanket). Let's be sure we know how to prevent these things from happening.



### The Usual Suspects for Household Fires

1. Heater sets fire to laundry or catches onto other fabrics
2. Forgetting to properly turn off cooking equipment
3. Not completely putting out a cigarette
4. Electrical appliance malfunctions, etc...



### Prevention Measures!



1. Do not dry clothes near your heater
2. Make sure you also close off the gas flow when you finish cooking or use other safer methods of preparing food.
3. Be sure to monitor electrical cords and outlets

### Measures to Minimize Damage

1. Be sure to properly maintain all fire alarms and fire extinguishers at your disposal.
2. Elderly are in an easily evacuated area on the first floor and equipped with non-flammable sleeping gear and other fire safety gear
