#### Abuse Prevention for the Disabled

If you have any suspicions that a member of the disabled community may be on the receiving end of abuse, please do not hesitate to call the Abuse Prevention for the Disabled Center.

There are no officially appointed individuals to notify the center, so let's be sure to look out for each other.

What is considered abuse?

- Physical abuse: pinching, kicking, punching, overall hitting
- Mental abuse: verbal abuse, laughing at the person for their condition(s), ignoring
- Sexual abuse: stripping the person in public, forcing indecent actions upon the individual
- Financial abuse: Withholding/swindling/manipulating the individual's salary/pension/savings, withholding money when it is within reasonable bounds to help the individual in a difficult financial position, etc.
- Neglect/Social abuse: withholding meals, pushing the individual(s) away/out of a social circle, denial of the individual(s) the right to undergo necessary treatments and/or receive other wellness services, etc.
