

# Are You Ready for Snow? Winter is Coming

We would like to extend a friendly warning to residents of Fukui City as a result of 2018's record-breaking snowstorm, which affected the everyday routine of all residents. We are currently taking measures to improve our snow removal procedures. Be it prefecture-wide or nationwide, we plan to cooperate with as many organizations to ensure the safety of our citizens and are ready to take action.

We will be doing everything in our power on a macro level, but we also need you to be prepared on a micro level as well. Brace for the winter because winter is coming.

#### BEFORE SNOWFALL

#### Prepare Household Items

These items are not limited to just snowfall, but be sure to prepare for other emergencies in similar fashion (i.e. emergencies that may prohibit usage of electricity, running water, and/or gas). At the very least, be sure to have enough rations for 3 days and try to make the most out of it. These things include food rations, water, flashlight, portable stove/burner, and kerosene/oil. Be sure to bring other things such as high pressure gas containers, batteries, chargers, etc. as well.

#### Prevent Water Pipes from Freezing

In order to prevent pipes outside of your residence from freezing, be sure to install heat insulated tubes or simply wrap your pipes with fabric. Also confirm whether or not there are any damages before and after wrapping the pipes.

#### Refrain from Driving

Due to snow and snow removal, the space available to traverse will be severely limited. We discourage driving in dangerous road conditions.

#### Label or Mark Important Items

There is a chance that important items may be damaged during snow removal processes. In order to reduce the chances of this happening to a minimum, marking your valuables in red is recommended.
