Food Poisoning Prevention Tips

The warmer the weather gets, the more suitable the environment becomes for bacteria to multiply. Fukui City would like to take this time to tell its citizens a few basic methods to help prevent food poisoning. Be aware of possible food hazards and learn 3 fundamental ideas behind the prevention of food poisoning.

1. Wash the Bacteria Away

There are plenty of bacteria on your hands. This is why it is important to make sure you thoroughly wash your hands **especially before cooking and after you use the bathroom**. Washing your hands twice is an effective option.

Make sure you separate all of your cooking utensils after usage when you are preparing raw meats (i.e. tongs, plates, chopsticks, etc.). An example of when this knowledge could be useful would be at a BBQ party or hot pot.

2. Minimize Bacteria Multiplication

In regards to perishable foods and other prepared foods that need to be stored, do NOT leave the food at room temperature for an extended period of time. Store the food in the refrigerator as soon as possible. The Danger Zone for most foods should be about 41-140 degrees Fahrenheit (roughly 5°C-65°C). The Danger Zone indicates the temperature range at which bacteria will multiply.

Keep in mind that bacteria will still multiply despite storing it in the refrigerator, so eating the food as soon as possible is ideal. Refrigerators are supposed to be kept under 5°C (41 Fahrenheit) so the food stays out of the Danger Zone. If the stored food cannot reach the target temperature within 2 hours, the food should not be consumed, and it should be discarded.

3. Kill the Bacteria

Simply heating food for one minute at 75°C (approximately 170 degrees Fahrenheit) will kill off the harmful bacteria.

Use hot water to make sure you kill harmful bacteria off of both the knife used to cut your raw meats as well as the cutting board. Kitchen-friendly, Chlorine-based bleaching agents are very effective in sanitization as well.
