Light Motor Vehicle Tax System Change

As you may know, the consumption tax rate will rise from 8% to 10%, effective October 2019. This section, we will be providing information about the tax system changes.

Out with the Automobile Acquisition Tax, in with the <u>Eco-Friendly Initiative Tax!</u>
 *The application form itself will change, but the overall procedure will not.

- ♦ What is the <u>"Eco-Friendly Initiative Tax"</u>?
 - New or old, if the price of the vehicle exceeds 500,000 Japanese Yen, this tax will be applied.
 - This rate of tax depends on factors such as gas emissions, gas mileage, etc., in other words, the vehicle's "eco-friendly" capabilities, to determine the final tax rating.

- 2. Light Motor Vehicle Tax will now be divided into two combined taxes: the previously mentioned **Eco-Friendly Initiative Tax** and the **Type Tax**
- \diamond What is the Type Tax?
 - It is simply an updated name for the old Light Motor Vehicle Tax. The name will be changed to "Light Motor Vehicle Tax (Type Tax)".
 - > The Type Tax applies to all purchases on and after April 1, 2019. The tax rate above does not apply.
- 3. The Eco-Friendly Initiative Tax will be temporarily reduced!

For a limited time (October 1, 2019 – September 30, 2020), upon purchasing a light motor vehicle (personal-use automobiles), the **Eco-Friendly Initiative Tax** will be **temporarily reduced by a flat 1%**!

- > In reference to the chart above:
 - \checkmark If the tax rate is 2.00%, it gets reduced to 1.00%!
 - \checkmark If the tax rate is 1.00%, it is now tax free!
 - ✓ Used cars are also eligible for this tax reduction!
