Message from the Mayor

Fukui Prefecture's "Special Warning on the Spread of COVID-19" order has been extended to April 10, 2022.

More than half of the cases have been a result of household transmission. Over 20% of cases have occurred at schools and nursery schools.

In order to protect yourself as well as the lives of your family, friends, and loved ones, I ask for your cooperation in the following.

- Please wear a mask when having conversations with others, even during meals.
- Seniors and those with underlying medical conditions are asked to please wear a mask even at home and avoid crowds when going out.
- Family members in the same household should practice safety measures to prevent household transmission as much as possible.
- If you have traveled between prefectures, or if there have been cases in your area, please consider the fact that you may be infected as well and immediately start taking safety measures at home.
- If you have a sudden fever or begin to show symptoms, either consult your family doctor or call the Fukui Prefecture Consultation Center for COVID-19.

Those living with you should also refrain from going to school or work.

• Please make an appointment for the COVID-19 booster shot (3rd dose) as soon as you receive your vaccination ticket.
