

How to separate and dispose of your garbage

- Bring garbage to the specified garbage station before 7:00am.
- Put no more than 5 kg of garbage into one bag.
- Always write the name of your residents' association or condominium.

- Which garbage you can dispose at the garbage station differs depending on the stations.
- Make sure your garbage is separated collectly.
